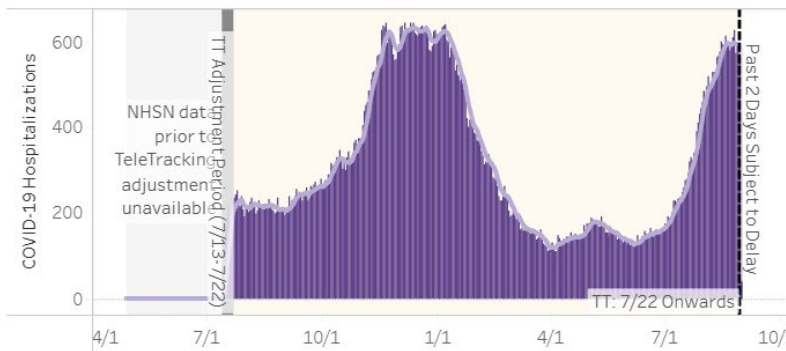

1. Inventory Tracking

- Binax Now – 153 tests; ID Now – 639 test
- Moderna 1st dose - 150; 2nd dose –494
- Janssen 215
- Pfizer 1st dose and 2nd doses – 250
- Last 2 weeks data: 409 Immunizations given, 314 tests performed

2. LTCF/Community Testing and Vaccination

3. Staffing

We currently have 3 LPNs and 7 CNAs

General Population-

The actual rollout will depend on a review by the CDC's Advisory Committee on Immunization Practice the week of August 30th. The roll-out for recipients of the two-dose mRNA vaccines is expected to begin with **high-risk individuals, nursing home residents, and front-line medical workers.**
