

CDC: Child COVID-19 hospitalizations 10X higher for unvaccinated

Weekly COVID-19 hospitalization rate among children in the U.S. rose rapidly from late June to mid-August, with the risk of hospitalization nearly 10 times higher among unvaccinated children, according to the CDC's Sept. 3 Morbidity and Mortality Weekly Report.

The report was based on information from the Coronavirus Disease 2019- Associated Hospitalization Surveillance Network database.

Six notes:

- 1. For the week ending June 26, the hospitalization rate per 100,000 children was 0.3. By Aug. 14, it rose to 1.4, marking a nearly five-fold increase.
- 2. The increase was highest among younger children, with the rate rising nearly 10 times for those ages 0-4 across the same six-week period.
- 3. The hospitalization rate among unvaccinated adolescents aged 12-17 was 10 times higher compared to those who were fully vaccinated.


We currently have 3 LPNs and 8 CNAs (one in orientation 9/13)





What's New!

- The Missouri Poison Control has continued concerns about the recent intentional misuse of the ivermectin as a preventative or treatment of COVID-19. As of mid August the center has managed at least 22 cases in 2021 as compared to 2 cases in 2020.
- Adverse effects that have been noted from an overdose of ivermectin include nausea, vomiting, and diarrhea. Patients have also experienced hypotension, dizziness, decreased consciousness, confusion, agitation, and hallucinations. The Poison Control Center does not recommend taking ivermectin that is not prescribed by a human healthcare provider.
