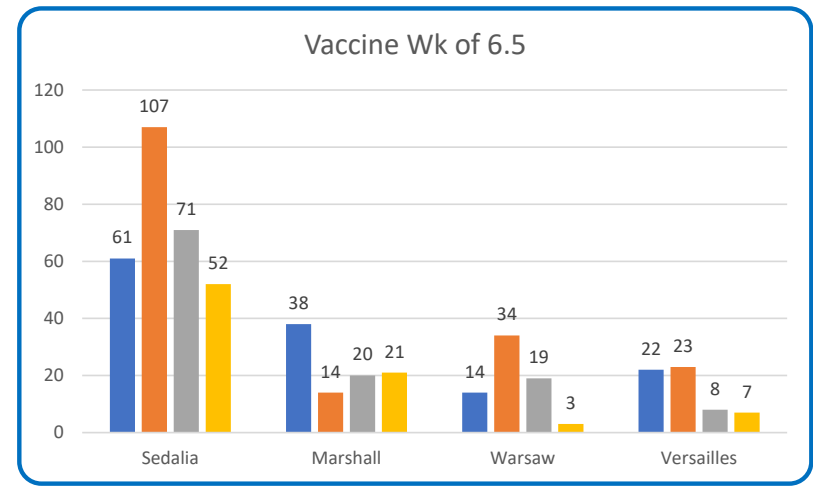
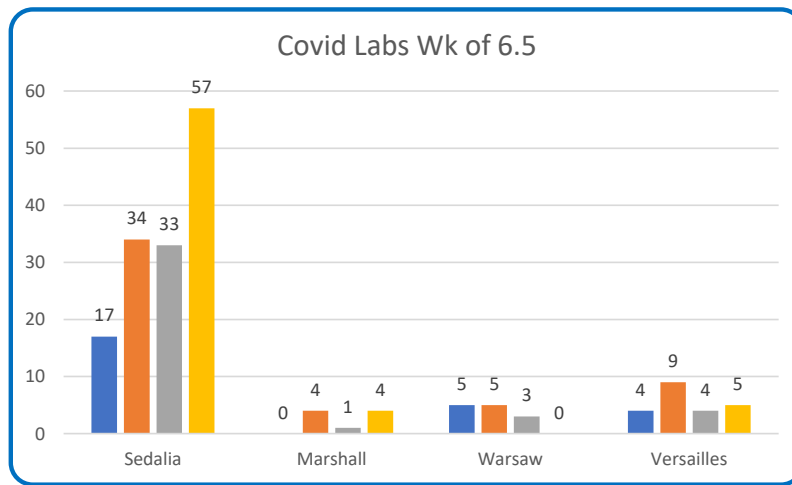

2. LTCF/Community Testing
 - We vaccinated over 60 people at Stanley Black and Decker!!
 - Testing Big Bend on the week of 6/21
 - August 7 (1 PM - 4:00 PM) and August 19 (10:00am - 2:45pm)
SFCC has asked us to come out and test the incoming residence for the dorms.
 - SFCC has asked us to come 8/11, 8/25, 9/8, 9/22, 10/20, and 11/10 to vaccinate on campus.



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- A new “COVID-19 Vaccination Screening and Consent Under EUA” has been issued by the State of Missouri Bureau of Immunizations. The update removes the “phases” and widens the health history and also address minors taking the vaccine.
- Janssen has extended expiration dates to 4.5 months. So we need to check online for correct expiration dates.
- Please continue to hold the “expired” Moderna your clinic has. Bureau of Immunizations has received notice that Moderna is determining new expiration guidelines for their vaccines!
